EVOC - Instructor Course completion is required to teach EVOC Modules A and B. Upon completion, EVOC Instructors may teach both EVOC and EVOC Refresher Courses.

Pre-requisites

- Current, active driver's license (not suspended)
- Auto Insurance
- Current EVOC certification, or equivalent as determined by the Alabama OEMS Rules. Apparatus Operator and Emergency Vehicle Driver (EVD) should also be current within last two years.
- Two years (minimum) ambulance operator experience (A letter from your agency's supervisor or training officer may be used to meet this requirement)
